Washington State:

The Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) will no longer accept the APHIS Form 7001

WSDA will accept the following;

- APHIS Form 7001 Multi-Page Carbon Copy assigned a unique certificate number by the USDA
- Global Vet Link https://www.globalvetlink.com/
- mCVI AgConnect through Texas A&M https://cvi.tamu.edu/saho/
- Small Animal Health Certificate generated on a software program that assigns a
 unique number to the certificate and includes all animal information, vaccination
 status, testing information when required and the veterinarians signature and
 accreditation number.
- All of these alternatives require an accredited veterinarian to submit the form.


Colorado:

- 1. https://ag.colorado.gov/animals/import-requirements
- 2. **Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)** Dogs and cats imported into <u>PACFA Licensed</u> <u>Facilities</u> are required to have a CVI within 10 days of entry and issued by an accredited veterinarian and stating that the dogs/cats are free from exposure to rabies.
- 3. Rabies vaccination current, for all dogs greater than 3 months of age
- 4. The VS Form 7001 is NOT accepted as a CVI for interstate travel to Colorado for any small animals.

Montana:

Montana requires an import permit and health certificate for entry of animals shipped into the state per Administrative Rule (ARM) 32.3.202.

Health Certificate requirements:

- The federal VS 7001 form is NOT an approved form of health certificate for shipment to Montana.
- Animals must be individually described with their current rabies vaccination status indicated on the certificate.
- The address of the animals origin must be indicated on the certificate.
- The Montana destination of the animals must be indicated on the certificate.

Permit Requirements:

- Fax or email the completed health certificate to the Helena, Montana office to request an import permit.
 - o Fax 406-444-1929 or email livpermits@mt.gov.
- Provide a return call telephone number or email address for the permit number.
- Health certificates issued using Global Vet Link or Agview electronic certificate systems do NOT require a permit number.
